

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SETTING UP YOUR TEAM'S FUNDRAISING PAGE

Go to <https://givingtuesday.mightycause.com/team/Hoc24> and follow these directions:

Click on "Join this team"

Log in if you aren't already, or register a new account if you don't have one

Click "Get Started" under the Start a Fundraiser prompt

Click "Create a New Fundraiser"

Click "Build Fundraiser"

Click "OK" in response to "Fundraiser Created from Template"

Click "Your Club Name" to rename your club's fundraiser to your club

Click on photo or video icon to personal your team's homepage

Select end date of March 3, 2024 on the Set Duration icon. Please note, we would love to continue to accept donations through the entirety of the competition. However, the contest winners will be determined by funds raised by Friday, March 1st at 5:00pm in order to coordinate logistics.

Scroll down to "Story" to edit template text to your liking

Click on eye icon on the left toolbar to review page

Click on the settings gear icon to create a custom URL ending.

Click on the rocket icon on the left toolbar to publish the page

E-mail out your link to your specific page and post on social media

Pro Tip: Whoever sets up your club's team page, when registering for an account, have them put in your team's name for the name, not their personal name. For example, First Name: Gymnastics, Last Name: Olympica. This will show the appropriate name on the Leader Board.

Next Step:

Have your families post about it on their social media.

Here is a sample e-mail you can send to your families for them to share.

We would love to win one of the prizes and we are even more excited to help raise money for Camp del Corazon.
